

Introduction:

The NSS Department of Late G. N. Sapkal College of Engineering conducted a 7-day Residential Camp in *Pegalwadi*, a village within *Taluka* Trimbakeshwar, from February 24, 2022, to March 02, 2022. The camp aimed to promote community engagement and social responsibility. One of the key activities organized during the camp was the "Water Reservoir Cleaning" initiative.

Water Reservoir Cleaning Activity:

The Water Reservoir Cleaning activity was a significant undertaking, involving a total of 150 participants. This inclusive group comprised 50 NSS volunteers, 90 first-year engineering students, and teaching and non-teaching staff from our college. The objective of this activity was to clean the water sources and reservoirs used by the villagers for drinking and daily needs. Additionally, some of these water reservoirs served as essential sources for animals to drink from.

Given the magnitude of the task and the number of water reservoirs in *Pegalwadi*, this activity spanned two days. Trimbakeshwar Municipal Council provided invaluable support by offering vehicles and cleaning equipment to facilitate the cleaning process. This collaboration exemplified the power of collective efforts in community development.

The success of this social cause was further enhanced by the active participation of the villagers of *Pegalwadi*. They joined hands with our volunteers and staff members, demonstrating their commitment to ensuring clean and safe water sources for their community.


