Impact and Significance

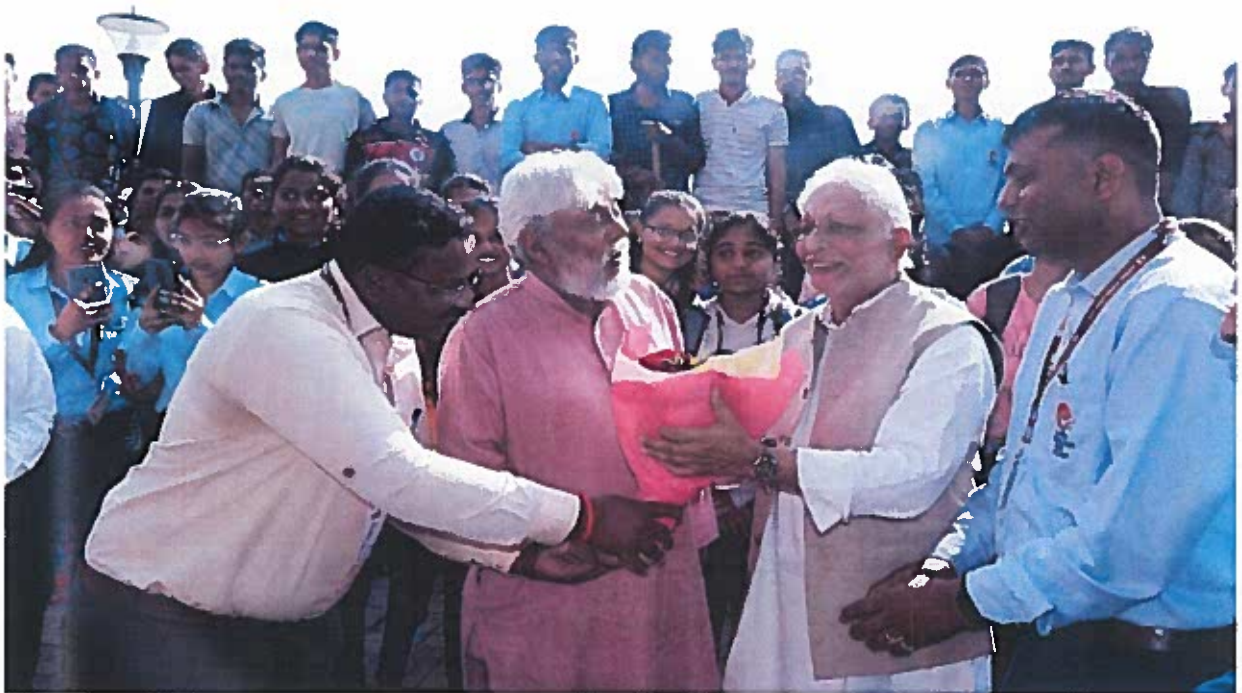
