Title of the Program: Blood check-up and AIDS Awareness Camp at Wadholi village.

Date(s): 23/01/2024 **Duration of the activity –** 1 Day

Introduction:

The NSS unit of KCT's Late G. N. Sapkal College of Engineering, in collaboration with the Red Ribbon Club and MahaLab, organized a blood check-up camp at Wadholi Village. This initiative was undertaken in response to the pressing need for medical diagnostic facilities in the village, which lacks a blood testing lab. The camp aimed to provide essential blood tests, including AIDS awareness and HIV testing, to the villagers. The activity was designed to offer comprehensive health insights and aid in the diagnosis and prevention of diseases.

The planning phase involved thorough coordination between the NSS unit, Red Ribbon Club, and MahaLab. Preliminary surveys were conducted to understand the health needs of the Wadholi village residents. After identifying the lack of blood testing facilities, a detailed plan was formulated to conduct the camp efficiently.

Volunteers from the NSS unit were trained on various aspects of the camp, including patient registration and maintaining hygiene standards. MahaLab, a reputable diagnostic service provider, agreed to conduct the tests and prepare detailed reports. The Red Ribbon Club provided materials and resources for AIDS awareness and HIV testing.

On the day of the camp, the team set up at a central location in Wadholi Village early in the morning. The site was equipped with necessary medical supplies, testing kits, and informational materials. The camp began with a registration process where villagers were noted down for various tests.

Blood Tests:

The blood tests included basic health screenings such as hemoglobin levels, blood sugar, cholesterol, and more. Special emphasis was placed on AIDS awareness and HIV testing, with separate booths and confidential handling of results.

AIDS Awareness and HIV Testing: Volunteers from the Red Ribbon Club conducted informative sessions on AIDS, explaining modes of transmission, prevention methods, and the importance of regular testing. Free HIV testing was offered, ensuring privacy and counseling for those undergoing the test.

Report Distribution:

The collected blood samples were sent to MahaLab for analysis. Within a week, detailed reports were prepared and distributed to the villagers. Volunteers organized a follow-up visit to ensure that the reports reached every individual and to provide additional guidance based on the results.

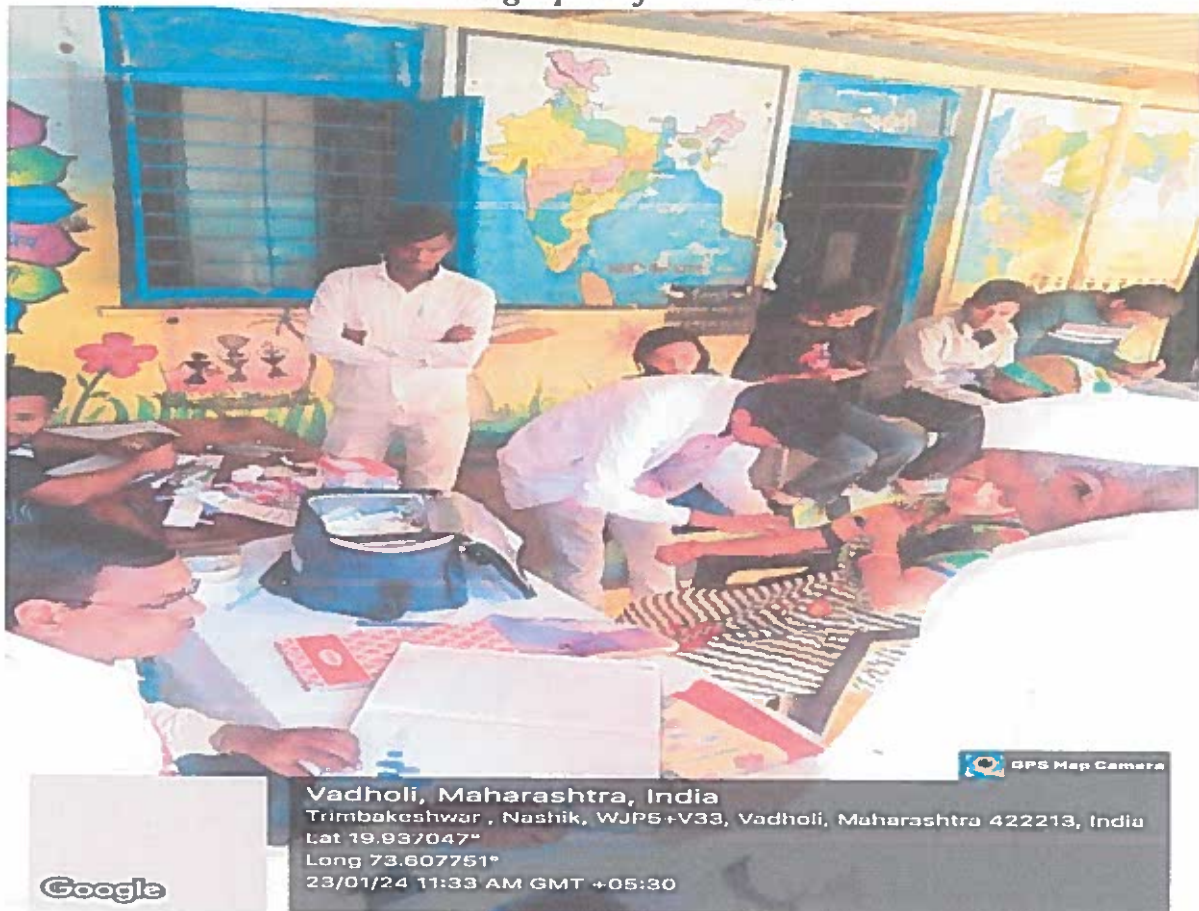
Participation
