

Introduction:

On the occasion of the birth anniversary of Late Mr. Rameshji Agrawal, the founder chairman of the Dainik Bhaskar Group, KCT's Late G. N. Sapkal College of Engineering participated in a blood donation drive. This noble event aimed to honor Mr. Agrawal's legacy by contributing to the community's health and well-being. The blood donation drive was conducted in collaboration with Jankalyan Blood Center, Nashik, ensuring professional medical supervision and efficient handling of the donated blood.

The preparation for the blood donation drive involved meticulous planning and coordination between the college administration, student volunteers, and the Jankalyan Blood Center. 
