Introduction:

The NSS unit of KCT's Late G. N. Sapkal College of Engineering embarked on a significant initiative to support the farmer community in Wadholi village by identifying potential avenues for additional income generation within the village itself. This report details the activities, findings, and potential recommendations based on a comprehensive entrepreneurship survey focused on the use and procurement of Organic Agarbatti & Dhoop sticks Made from cow dung.

Objective

The primary objective of the survey was to explore the feasibility of establishing a local Organic Agarbatti & Dhup manufacturing unit within Wadholi village. The goals included:

- 1. Assessing the demand for Organic Agarbatti & Dhoop sticksmade from cow dung within the village.
- 2. Understanding the current procurement practices of these products.
- 3. Gauging the villagers' willingness to purchase locally manufactured "Agarbatti & Dhoop sticks."
- 4. Identifying potential benefits and challenges in setting up a local manufacturing unit.

Methodology

- 1. Survey Design: The survey was designed to collect qualitative and quantitative data on the usage and procurement of Organic Agarbatti & Dhoop sticks. Key questions included frequency of use, sources of purchase, expenditure, and willingness to buy locally produced items.
- 2. Data Collection: NSS volunteers visited each household in Wadholi village, engaging with residents through face-to-face interviews. The data collection spanned over a week, ensuring comprehensive coverage of the village population.
- 3. Data Analysis: The collected data was analyzed to identify patterns, preferences, and the overall demand for "Organic Agarbatti & Dhoop sticks."

Recommendations:

The detailed recommendation report was submitted to the Gram Panchayat based on the survey conducted by the students and discussions were also conducted with Village sarpanch and Gramsevak Officer regarding this entrepreneurship opportunity in the village.
