Impact and Significance

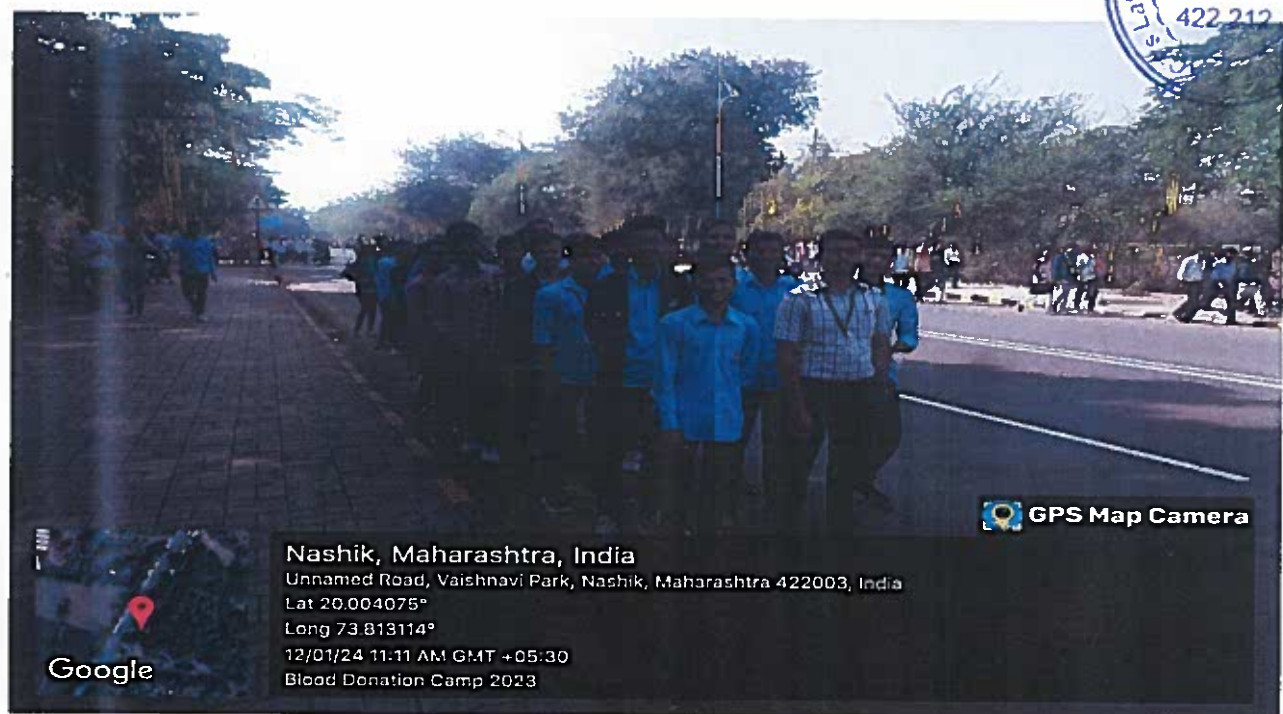
