Impact and Significance

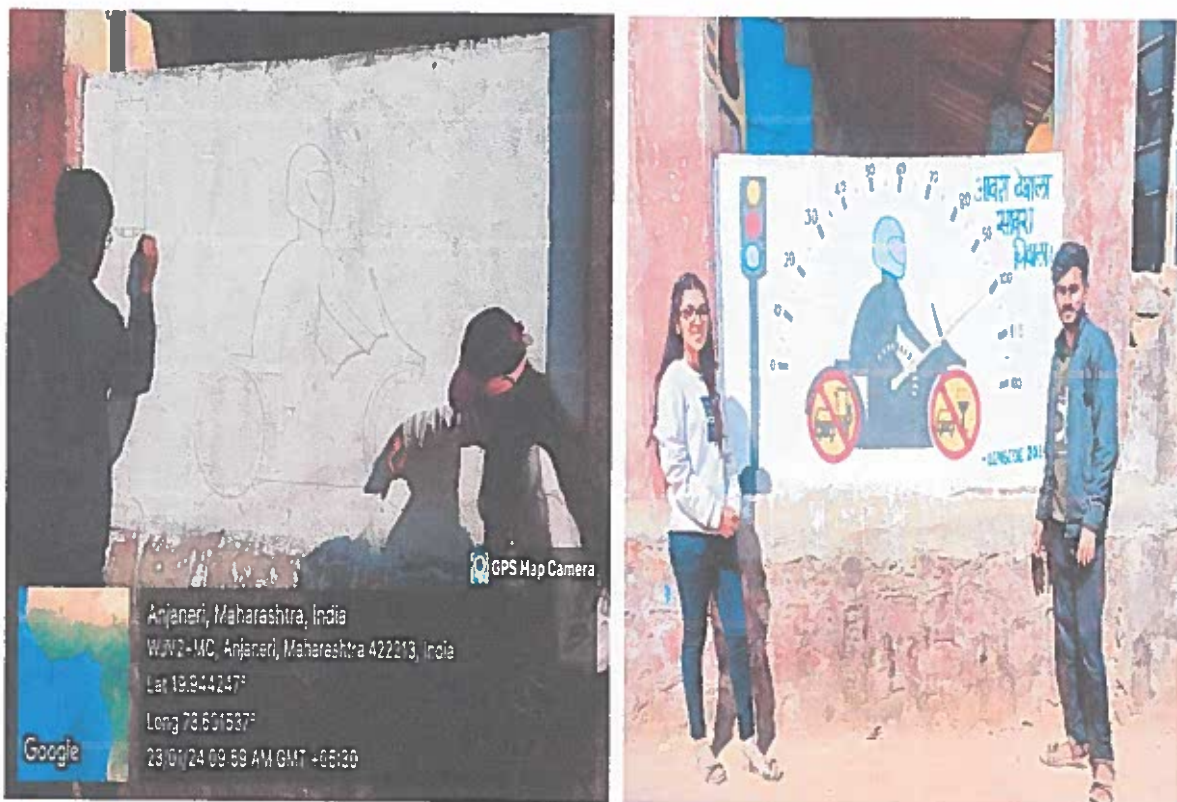

Conclusion

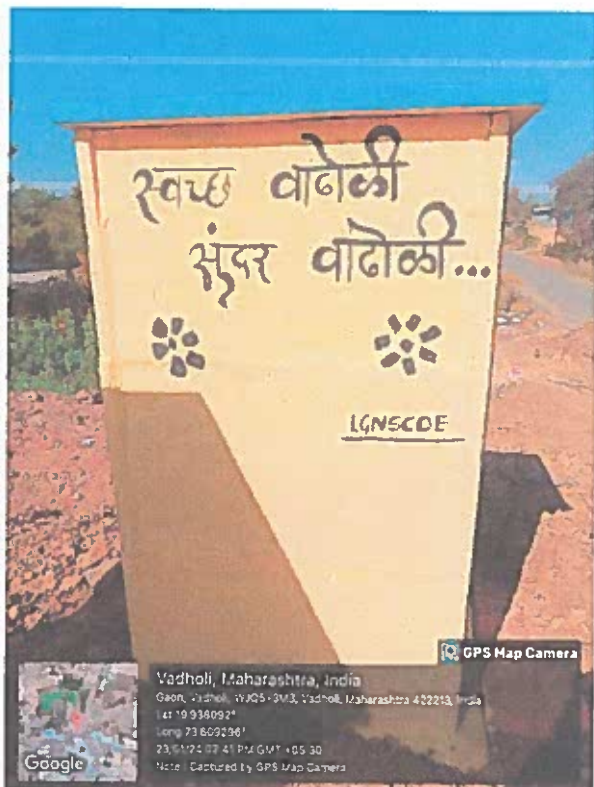
