B. Measures Initiated by The Institution for The Promotion of Gender Equity

The institute implemented such programs to promote education which would be sensitive to the needs of all genders and various sections of the society. In addition, to ensure that the students of all the genders are given equal opportunities to develop into responsible citizens, the staff members ensure an equal participation and involvement while forming teams and groups in almost all the activities including, sport events, cultural events, project groups, seminar groups etc. Furthermore, to maintain gender balance in various departments, the Institute ensures the provision of equal opportunity during the admission process irrespective of the gender; the Institute has a zero-tolerance policy against the workplace harassment. Institute also has maintained a fair gender balance among the employees working on key positions.

To create a safe, secure and healthy environment the Institute has taken following initiatives:

a) Committees & Groups Compositions:

- The Institute makes a conscious effort to include a minimum of one representative person from male and female gender in committee and group composition.
- A staff member makes sure that students of all genders are present in each group.

b) Presence of Female on key Administrative & Governing Position:

- Vice Chair-Person is one of the most important administrative and governing position in Kalyani Charitable Trust serve by the Female Administrator.

c) Internal Complaints Committee:

- A cell and clearly defined process are in place at the Institute to address cases of sexual harassment of students and staff.
- A number of sessions are held to foster a strong moral sense and values in order to foster amicable relationships between male and female employees.

d) Safety and Security Measures:

- In our institute, safety & security of all has always been a priority and special attention is given to safety of women. The institute has taken awareness of this aspect right from the day of its establishment in following ways:
 1. Dedicated security for staff and students.
 2. CCTV camera for campus security and monitoring.
 3. Internal Complaints Committee (formerly Women Grievances Cell)
 4. Discipline monitoring committee, Anti-ragging cell, student council, staff and student grievances cell.
 5. A full-time rector in the girl's & boy's hostel.

e) Staff Grievance Redressal Committee:

- The Institute has established a Staff Grievance Redressal Committee, chaired by

the Principal and composed of senior faculty members.

- The committee and its procedures are designed to uphold the organization's commitment to offering a just and equal work environment and opportunities to all employees.
- The clearly defined Grievance Redressal Process gives faculty members a convenient way to resolve grievances.

f) Counselling & Mentoring (Teacher-Guardian Scheme):

- Every student enrolled in the institute is assigned a teacher-guardian. Regular teacher-guardian meetings are utilised for discussing about a variety of issues and problems (both personal and academic) that are raised by their mentees.
- In addition, the institute provides assistance and moral support to students who require counselling.

g) Facilities for Ladies

- Girls Common Room: The institute has a common room for resting, which is well-equipped with a bed, chairs, lockers, and drinking water exclusively for girls.
- Ladies Washrooms: A washroom cleaned regularly for hygiene purpose & the facilities with sanitary napkin system are available in the washroom.
- Day Care Facility: Institute has Day Care Facility to benefit and support the female employees and their kids.
- Female Doctor: Full-time in-house campus female doctor is appointed to facilitate medical services to all female staff and girl's student.

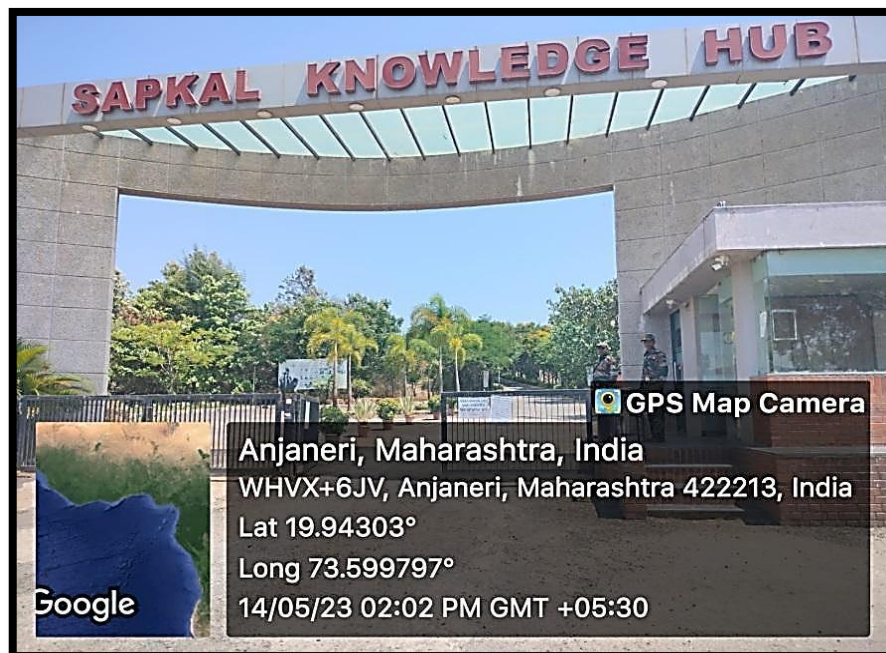


The campus of the Institute is made secured with 24-Hour working high resolution CCTV cameras installed at all the strategic location within the campus.



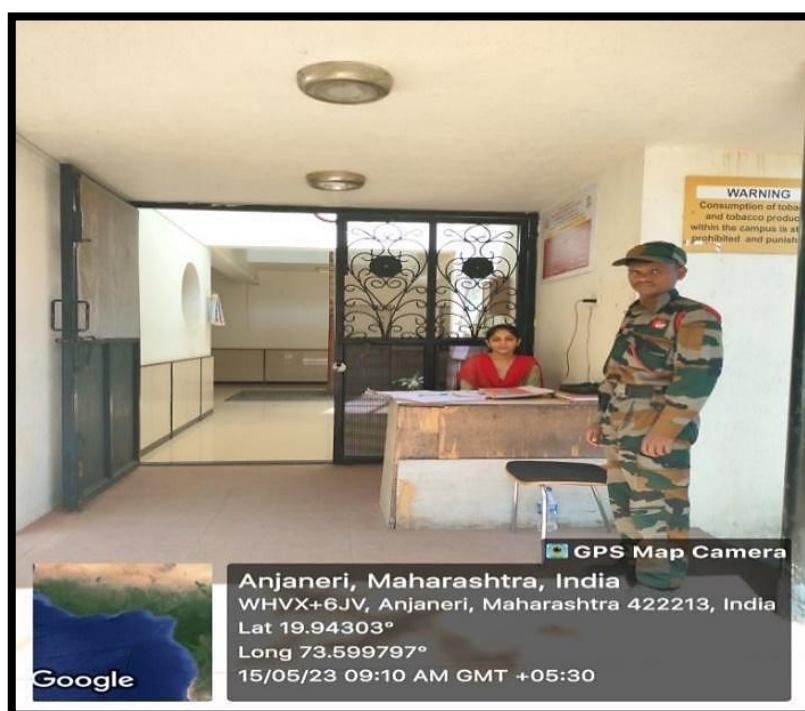
Ragging Means and Punishment for Ragging Boards are displayed in Institution campus for awareness.

- Additionally, the institute offers counseling to students in need of moral support and guidance.

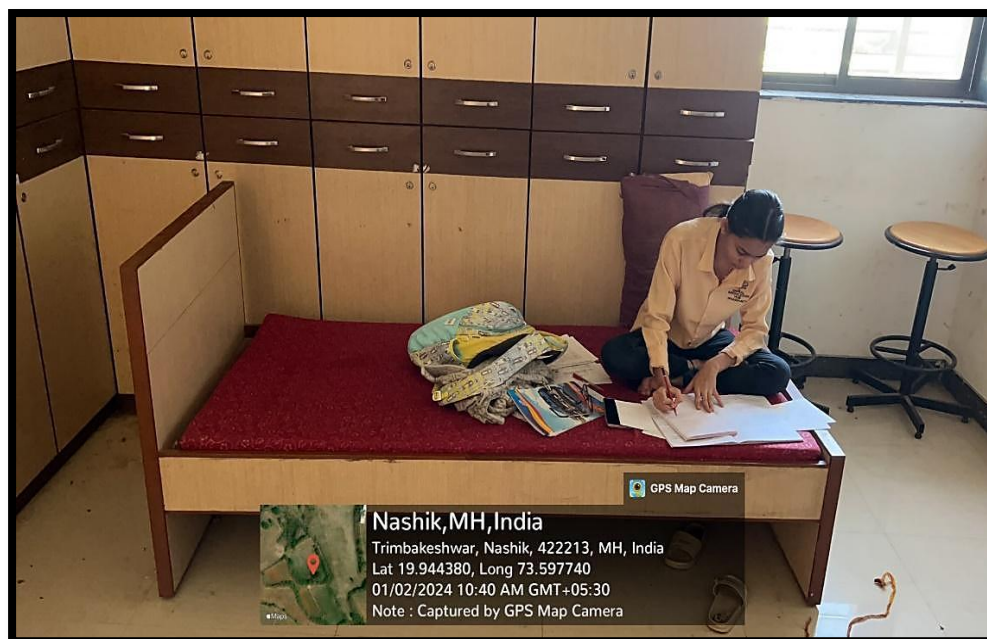
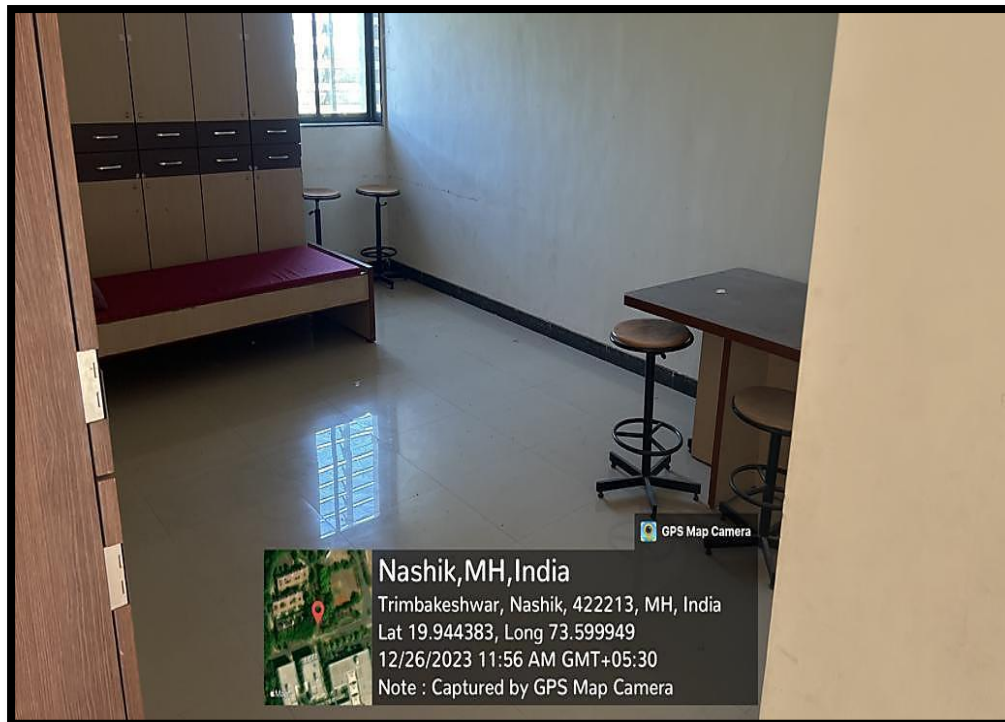


7. Facilities for Ladies:

Institute has a day care facility available to benefit and support the female employees and their kids. Recreational facilities like indoor games and toys are available for children.

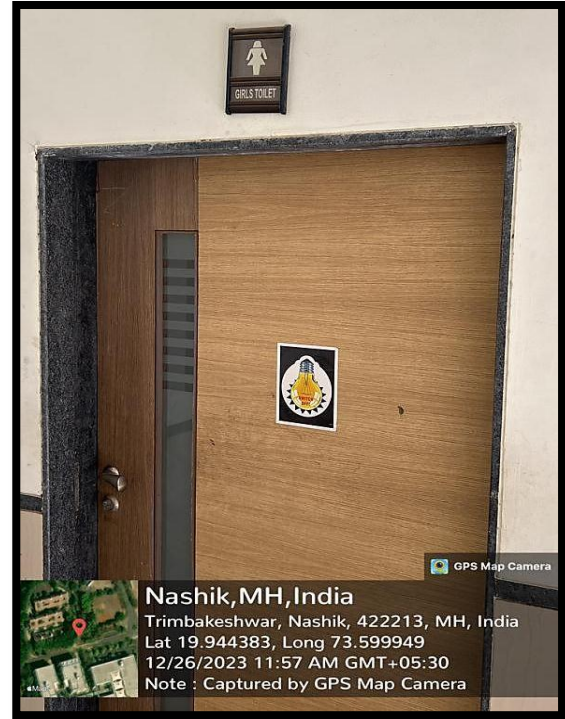


Sanitary Napkin Machine Ladies:
